

## 8<sup>th</sup> Annual Safe and Sober Spring Family Night



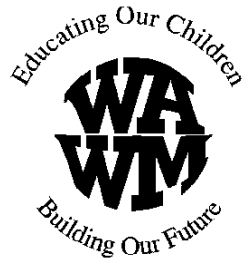
Over 400 students and parents attended the 8th Annual Safe and Sober Spring Family Night on May 1<sup>st</sup> at Central High School. Coalition youth members were on a panel, moderated by Central Principal Dr. Amy Van Deuren, sharing a positive message and promoting safe choices for having a fun and safe prom, graduation and summer.



Corporal Rod Nelson from the West Allis Police Department reminded everyone about the consequences of underage substance abuse. Parents were asked to share and sign the Family Pledge with their children and the Parents Who Host, Lose the Most campaign signs were also distributed.

Gift certificates from seven local businesses, including restaurants, hair and nail salons and florists were raffled at the end of the program. Students who attended the family night with their parents/guardians received a \$15 voucher, parent or student only in attendance received a \$10 voucher off the purchase of their prom ticket.
