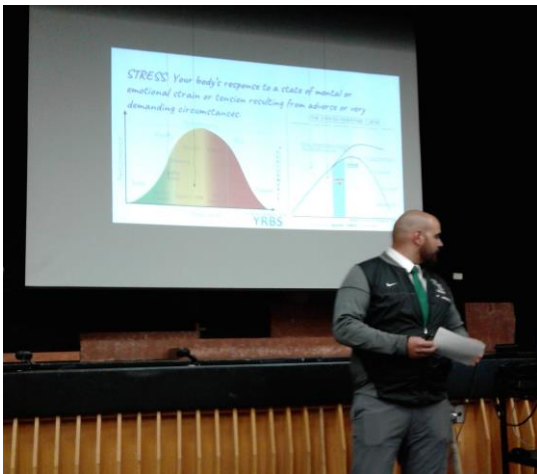


10th Annual Safe and Sober Spring Family Night



The 10th Annual Safe and Sober Spring Family Night was held on April 16, 2018 at Nathan Hale High School with about 300 parents and students attending. Working in collaboration with the West Allis-West Milwaukee School District, the West Allis Police Department, West Allis-West Milwaukee Heroin/Opiate Task Force and the West Allis-West Milwaukee Community Coalition, information was

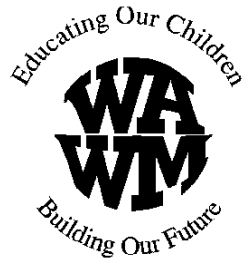
shared for parents and students on making positive choices and having a safe prom.



The speakers for the program included Evan Rossa, Health and PE Teacher from Nathan Hale, who spoke about stress management and positive ways to relieve stress for both parents and students. Parents were invited to visit the Teen Replica Room offered by the WAWM Heroin/Opiate Task Force. Youth members from the West Allis-West Milwaukee Community Coalition presented information about the Family Pledge that was then signed by the over 100 families in attendance. The youth also launched the Parents Who Host, Lose the Most campaign. The yard signs, posters and window clings from Parents Who Host are a reminder for parents not to hold underage drinking parties and for youth to have a safe and sober prom, graduation and summer.

Students who attended the family night with their parents/guardians received a \$15 voucher, which could be used toward the purchase of a prom ticket. Gift certificates from six local businesses, including restaurants, hair and nail salons and florists were raffled at the end of the program.
